2. Decisions

1. In order to end impunity in new Nepal, a formal letter will be submitted to the CA members on 28 May 2008, requesting them to raise this issue in the CA. The letter will contain a brief description of impunity and its devastating impact on every life of the people. Govinda Bandi has been assigned to draft the letter and present it for discussion at the Task Force meeting to be held on 22 May.
2. The meeting also decided to prepare a year long calendar incorporating major activities that will be carried out throughout the year. All members have been assigned to prepare a list of activities that could be incorporated in the calendar. Next meeting to be held on 22 May will prepare the Annual Calendar.
